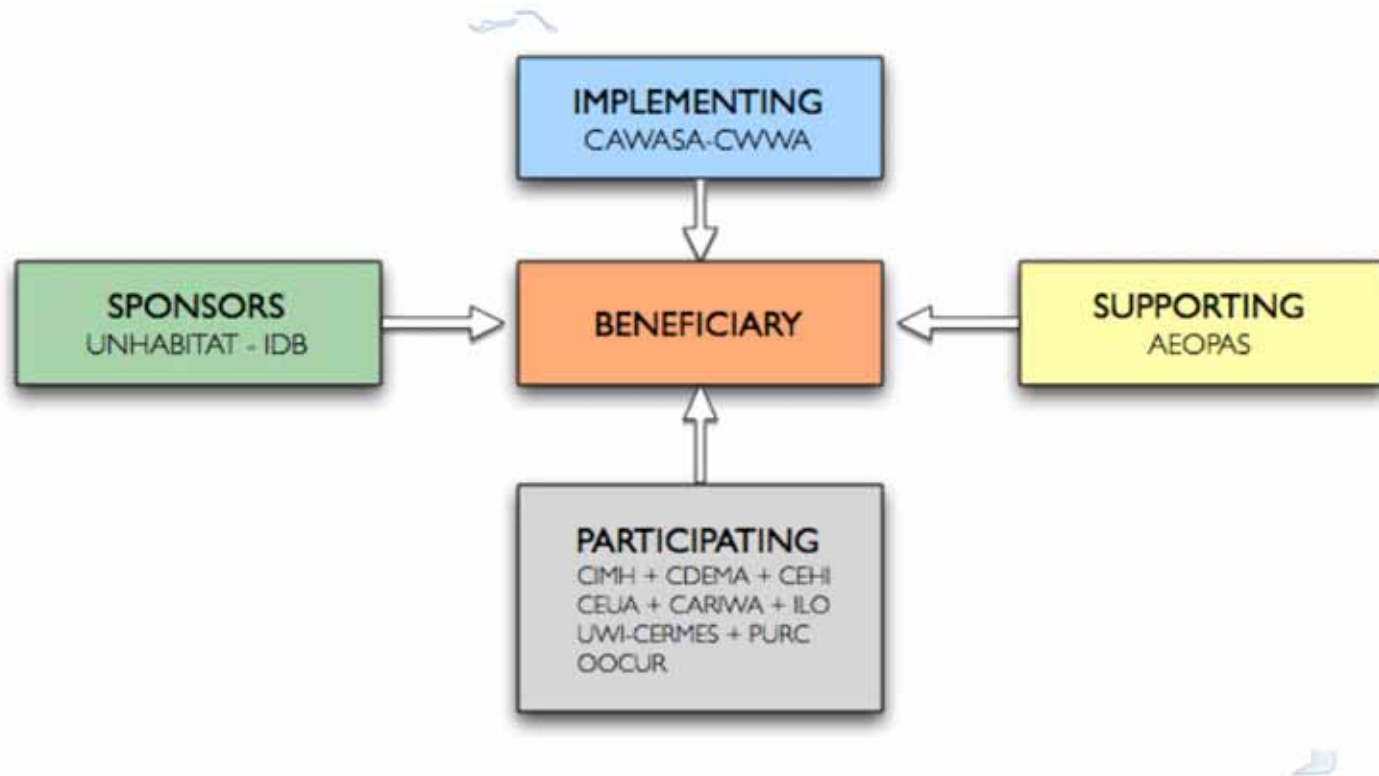

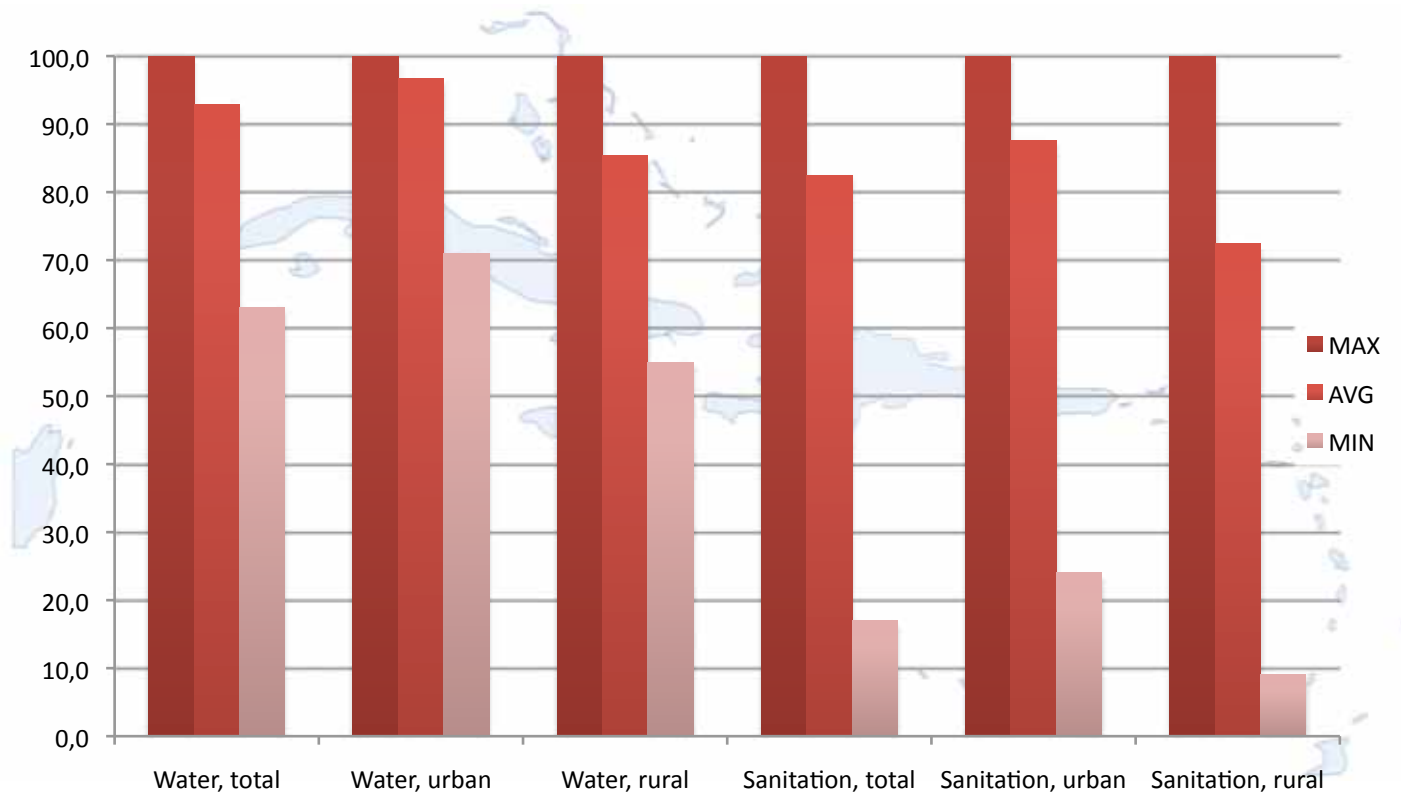

Key facts & figures

- ❑ High level of political involvement
- ❑ 50% non-revenue water
- ❑ 55% do not have independent regulation
- ❑ 65% without cost recovery policy
- ❑ Overstaffing: 8 employees / 1,000 connections
- ❑ Low wages
- ❑ Very wide range of utility characteristics
